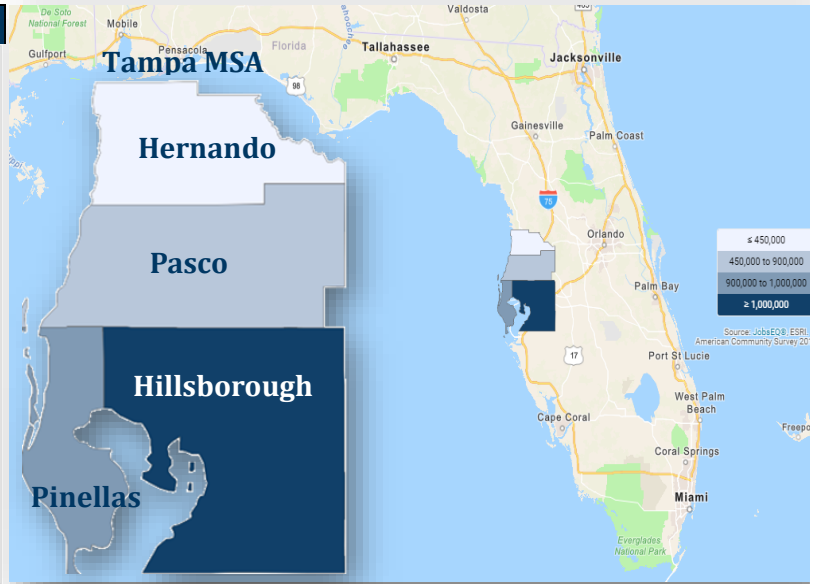
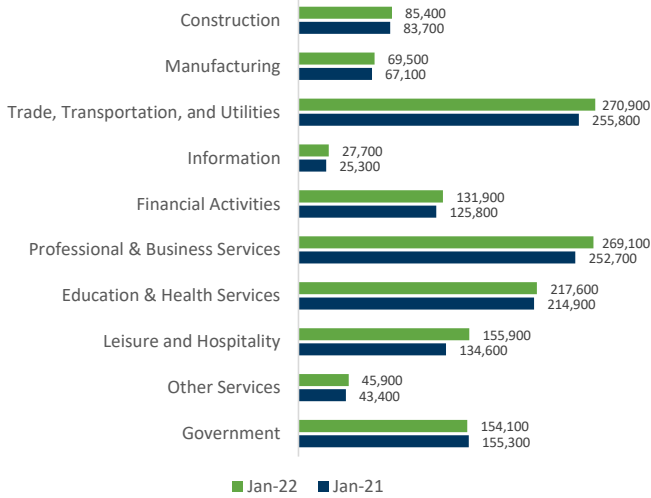
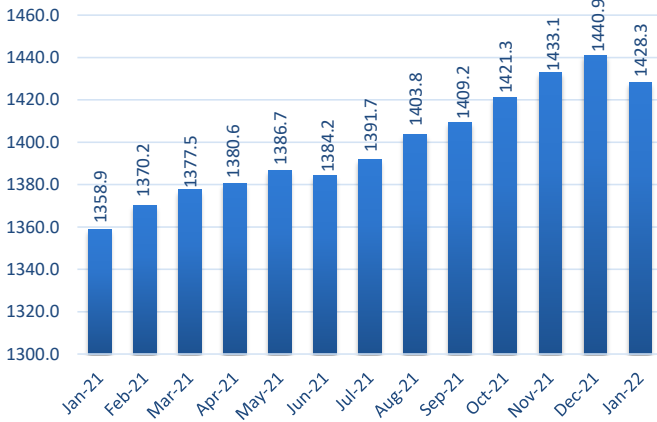


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment rose 69,400 or 5.1% since January 2021. Metros with the largest gains were Orlando (+110,500), Miami Beach-Kendall (+78,700) and Tampa (+69,400). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include leisure and hospitality (+21,300), professional and business services (+16,400), trade, transportation, and utilities (+15,100) and financial activities (+6,100). Professional and business services and education and health services currently account for 34% of the industry share.

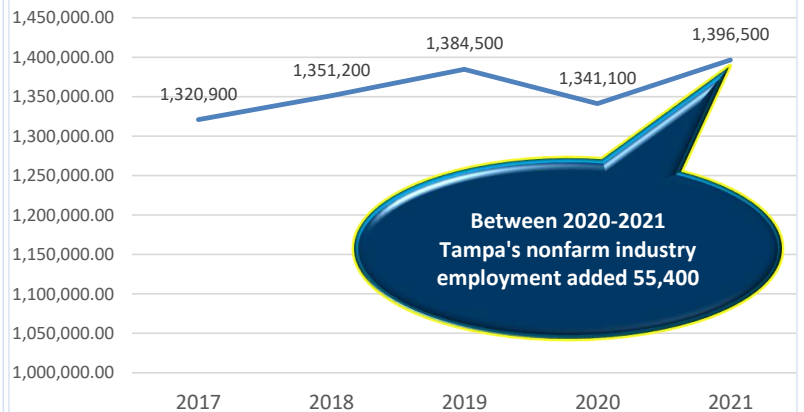
TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY



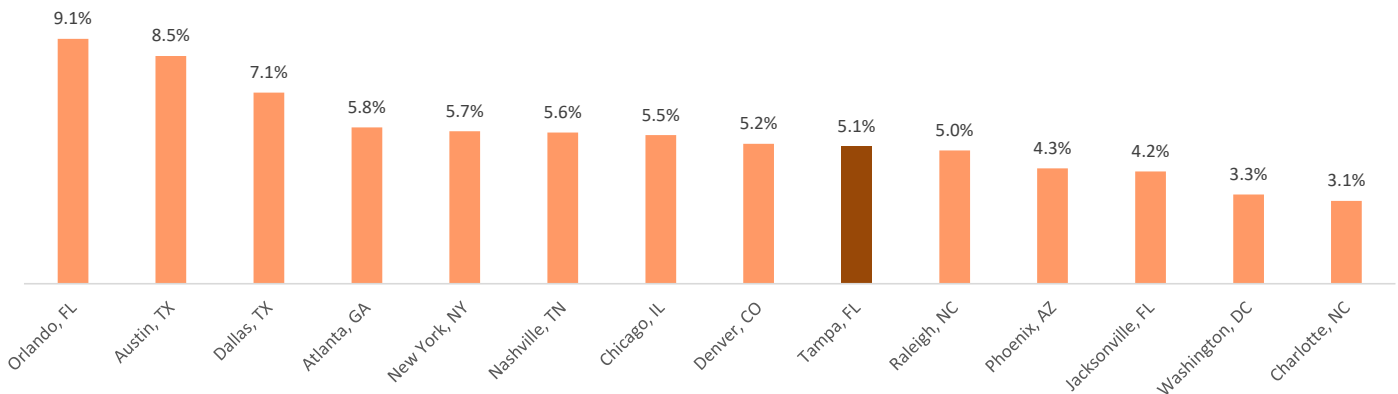
Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)
