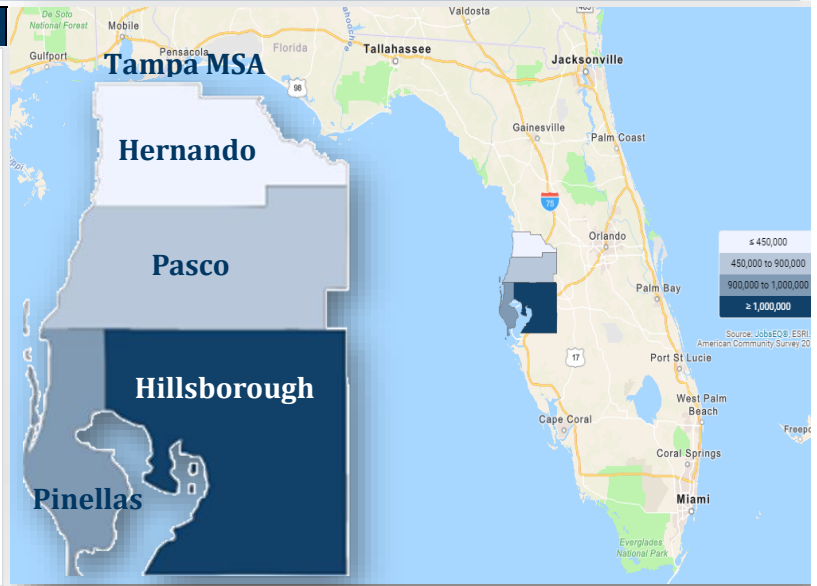
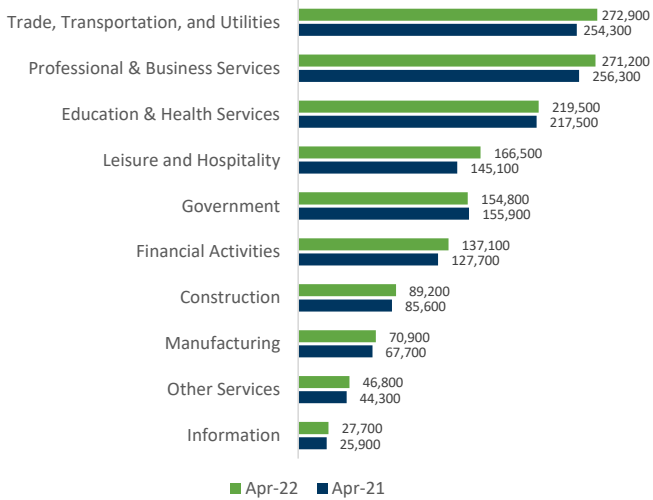
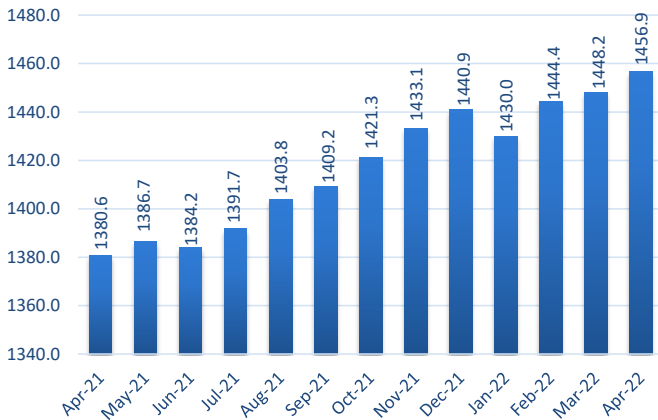


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment increased to 76,300 or 5.5% since April 2021. Other Florida metros with the largest gains were Orlando (+103,000 jobs, +8.3%) and Miami Beach-Kendall (+77,100 jobs, +6.6%). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include leisure and hospitality (+21,400), trade, transportation, and utilities (+18,600), and professional and business services (+14,900). Since March Tampa added 8,700 jobs. Professional and business services, trade, transportation, and utilities and education and health services currently account for 52% of the industry share.

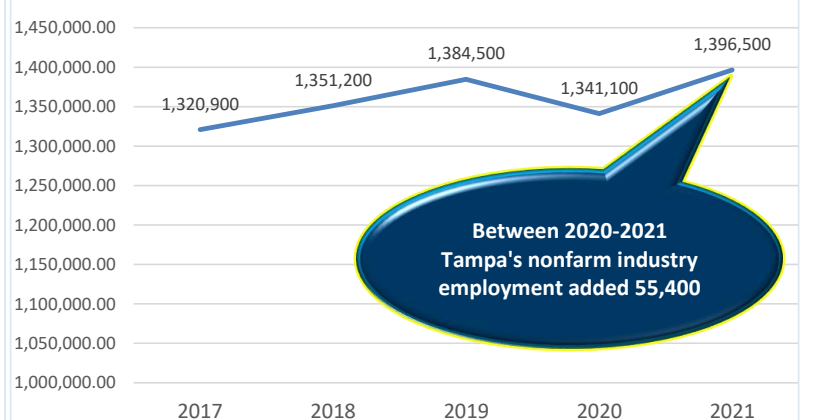
**TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY**



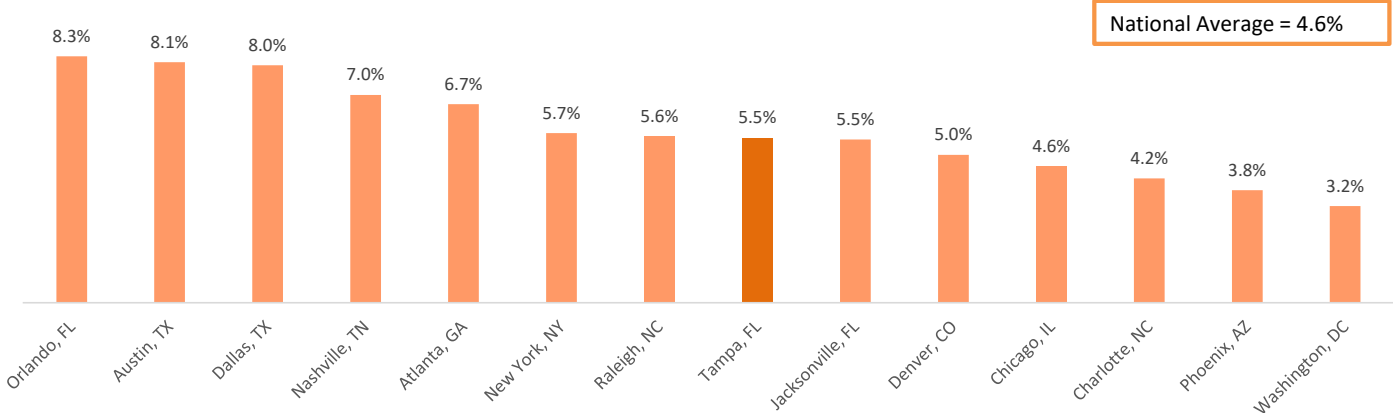
**Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)**
