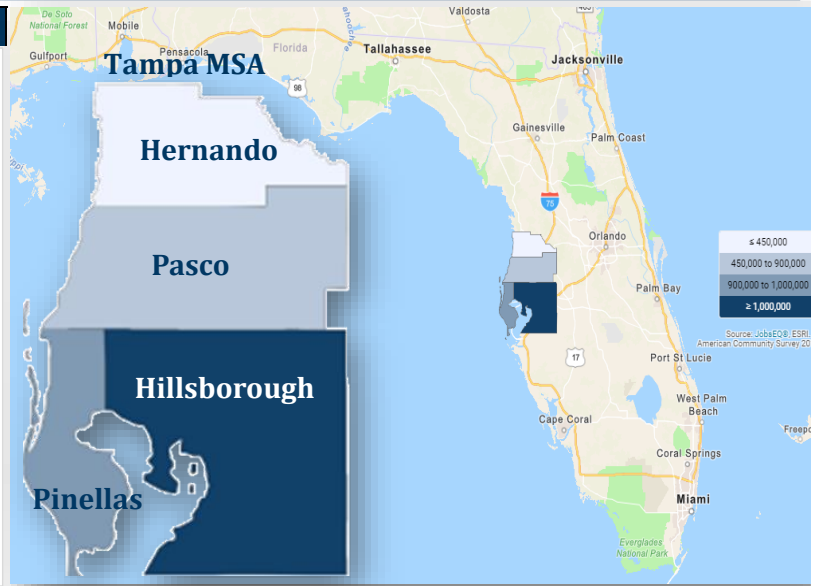
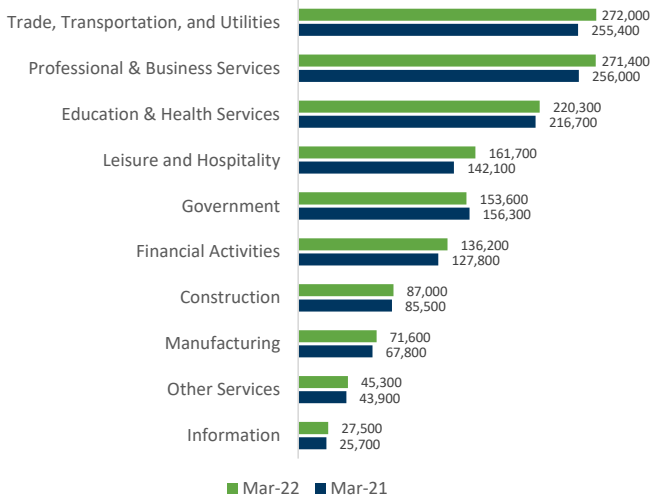
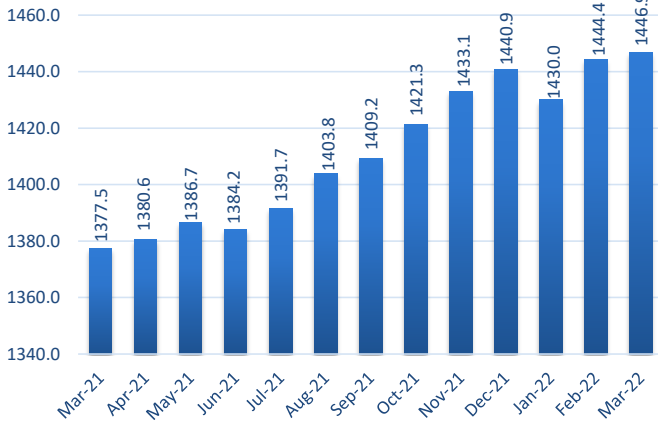


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment increased to 69,400 or 5.0% since March 2021. Other Florida metros with the largest gains were Orlando (+106,300) and Miami Beach-Kendall (+80,500). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include leisure and hospitality (+19,600), trade, transportation, and utilities (+16,600), and professional and business services (+15,400). Since February Tampa added 2,500 jobs. Professional and business services, trade, transportation, and utilities and education and health services currently account for 53% of the industry share.

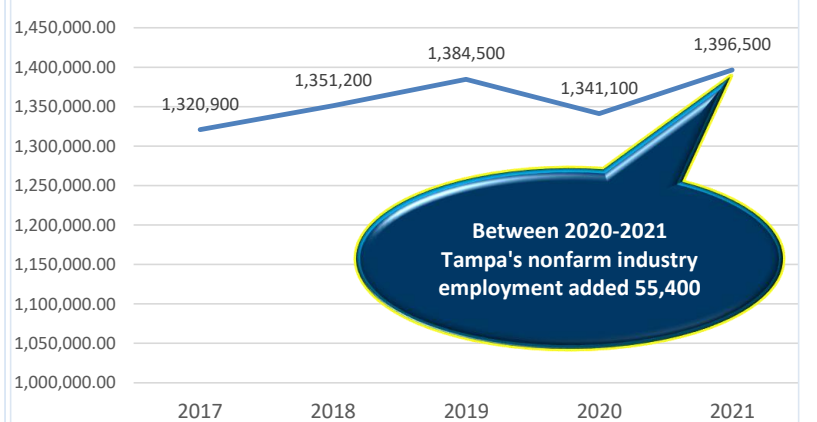
**TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY**



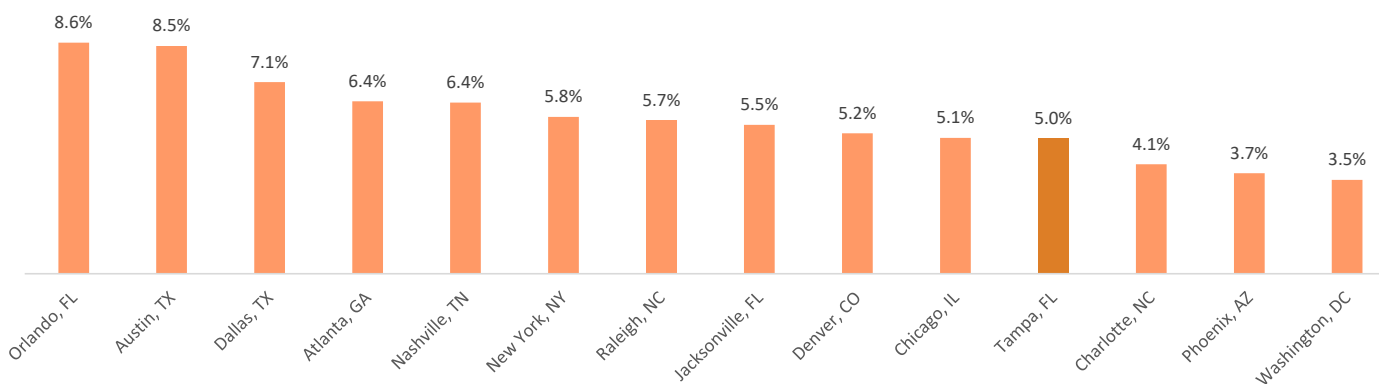
**Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)**
