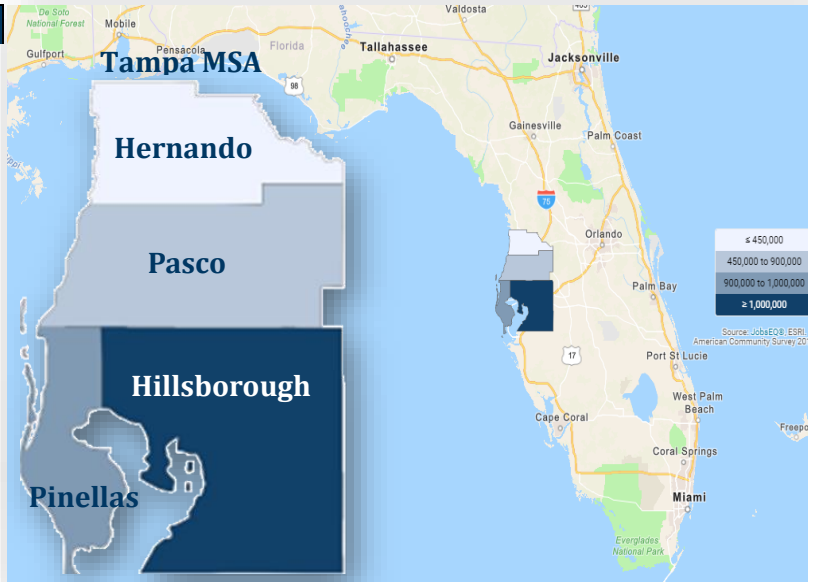
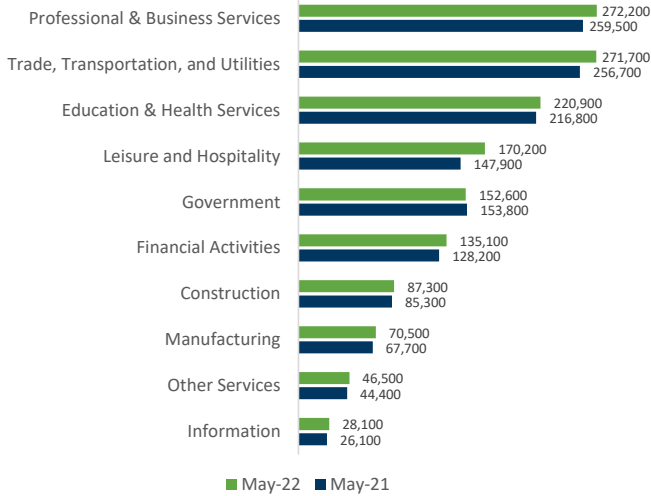
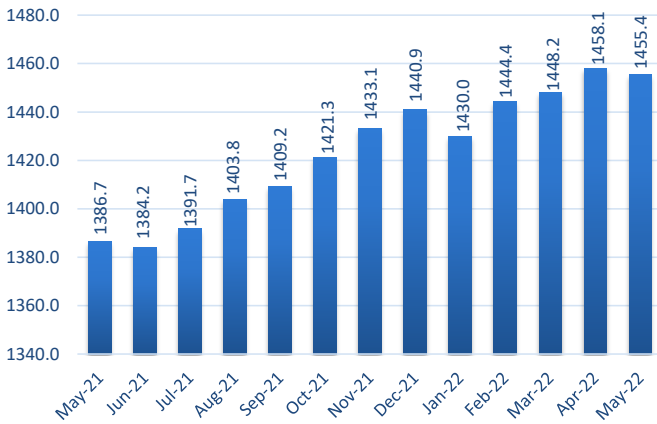


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment increased to 68,700 or 5.0% since May 2021. Other Florida metros with the largest gains were Orlando (+91,400 jobs, +7.3%) and Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+75,300 jobs, +6.5%). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include leisure and hospitality (+22,300), trade, transportation, and utilities (+15,000), and professional and business services (+12,700). Retail trade for general and other merchandise stores added 3,300 jobs year-over-year. Professional and business services, trade, transportation, and utilities and education and health services currently account for 53% of the industry share.

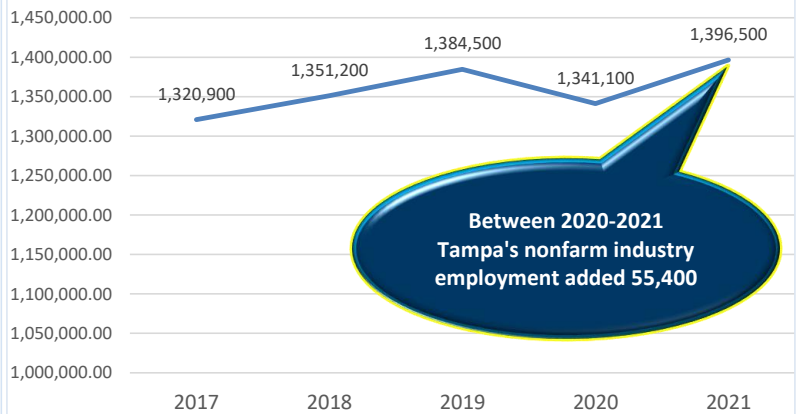
TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY



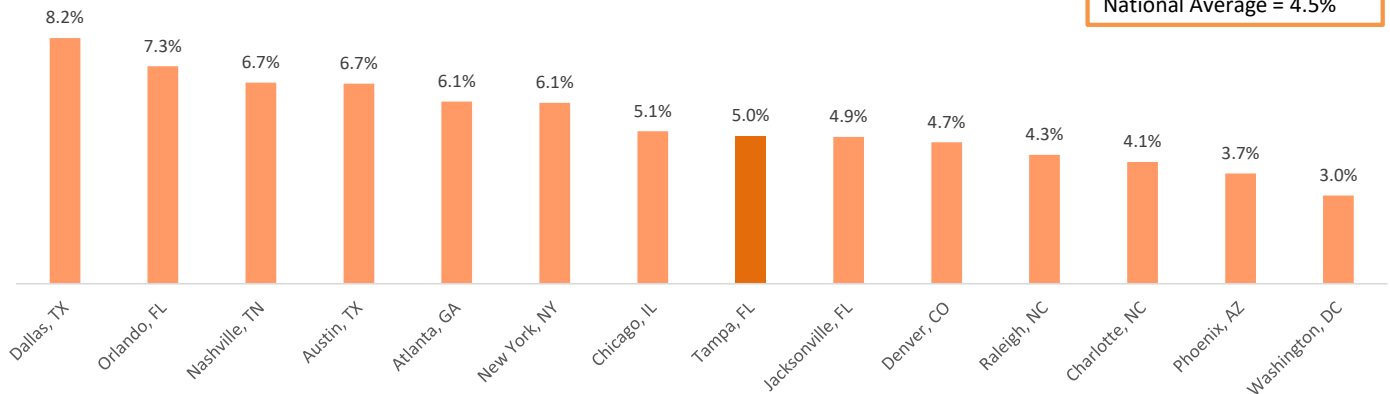
Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)
