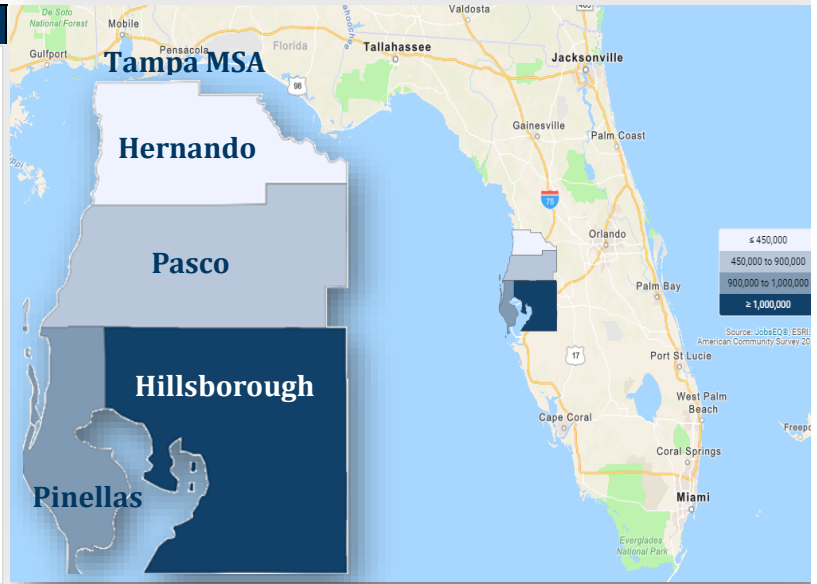
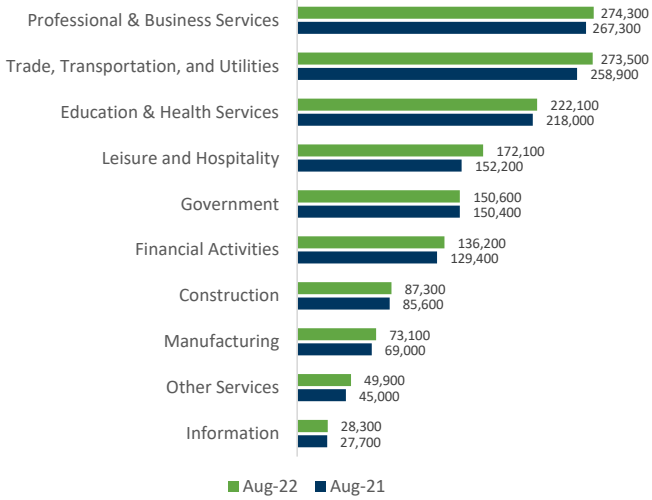
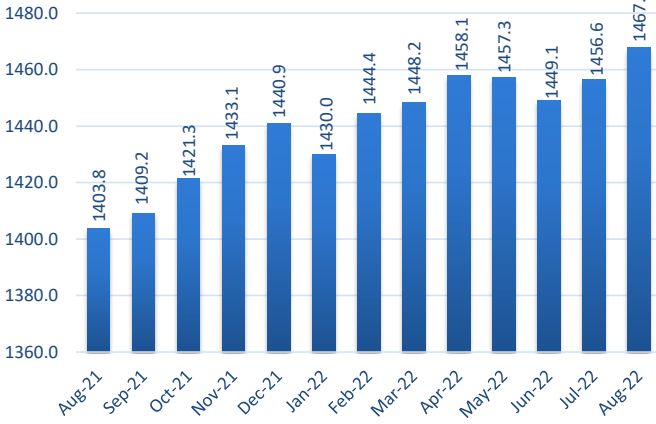


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment increased to 63,900 or 4.6% since August 2021. Other Florida metros with the largest gains were Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+80,400 jobs, +6.8%) and Orlando (+70,800 jobs, +5.4%). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include leisure and hospitality (+19,900), trade, transportation, and utilities (+14,600), and professional and business services (+7,000). Retail trade sector (which is included in trade, transportation, and utilities supersector) added 6,400 jobs year-over-year. Professional and business services, trade, transportation, and utilities and education and health services currently account for 52% of the industry share.

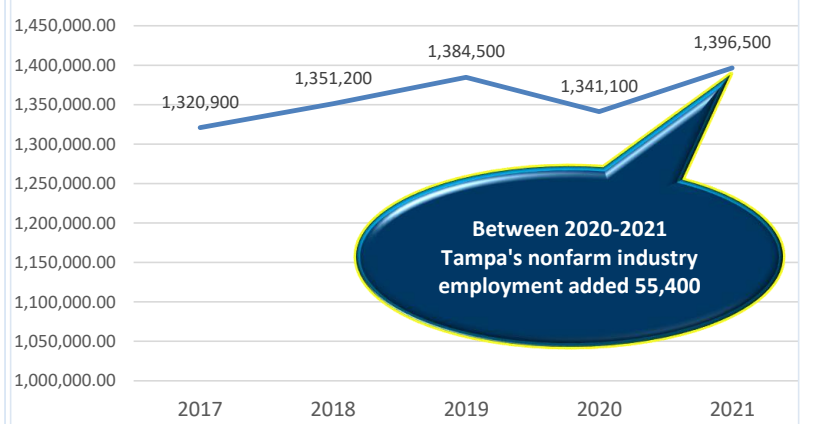
TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY



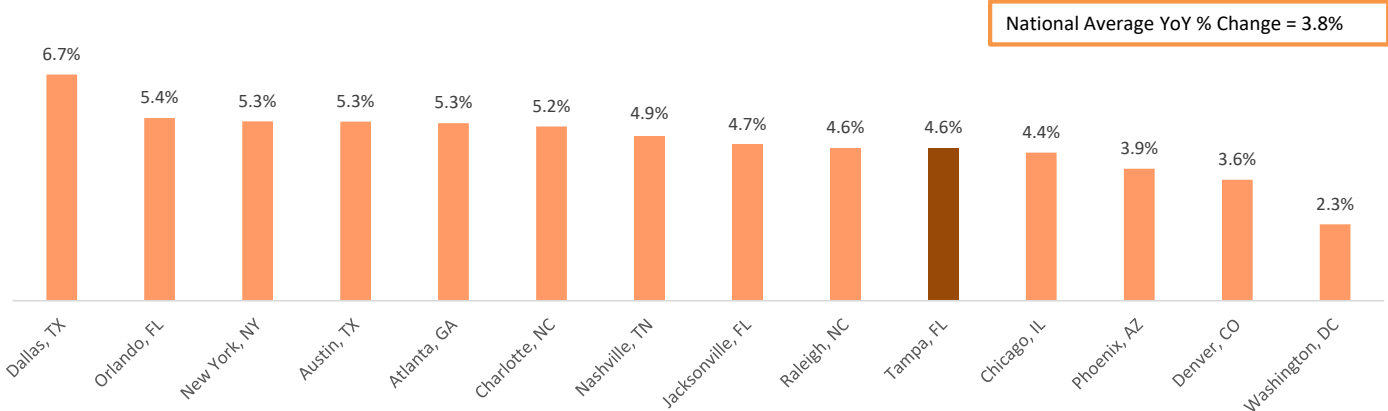
Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)
