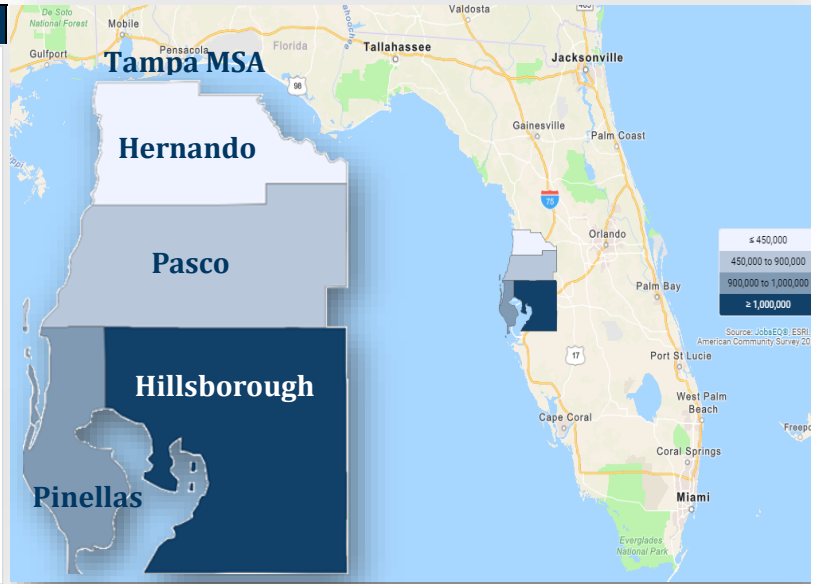
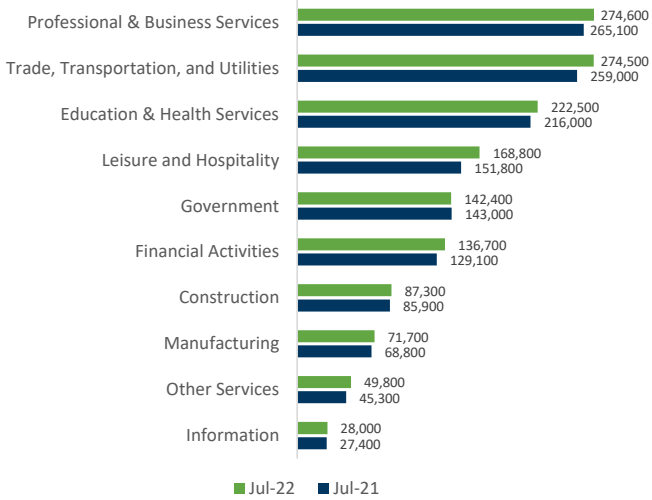
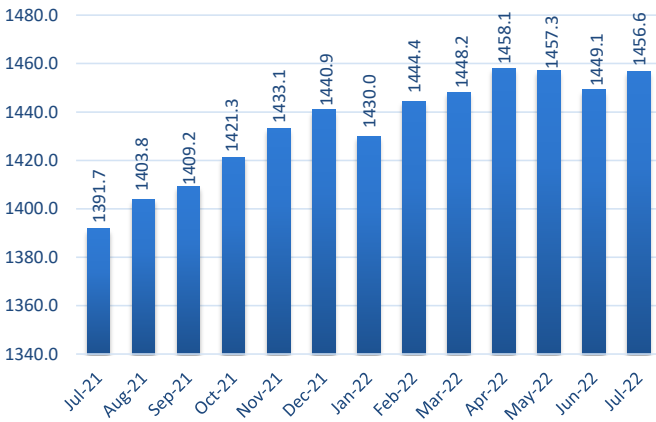


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment increased to 64,900 or 4.7% since July 2021. Other Florida metros with the largest gains were Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+80,000 jobs, +6.8%) and Orlando (+66,600 jobs, +5.2%). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include leisure and hospitality (+17,000), trade, transportation, and utilities (+15,500), and professional and business services (+9,500). Retail trade sector (which is included in trade, transportation, and utilities supersector) added 7,100 jobs year-over-year. Professional and business services, trade, transportation, and utilities and education and health services currently account for 53% of the industry share.

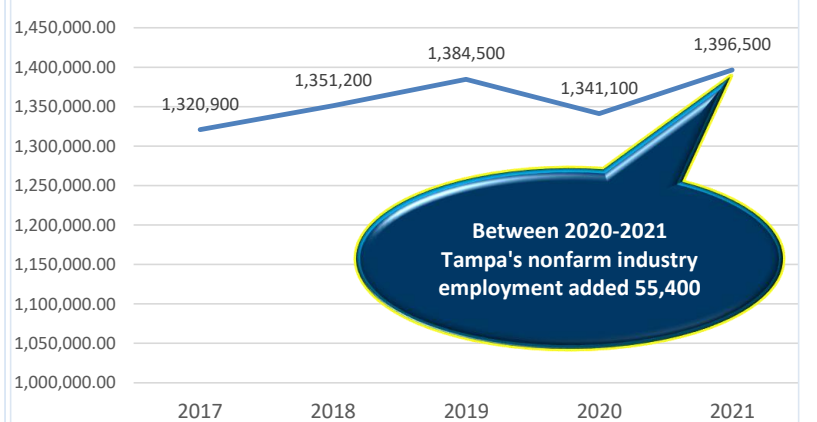
TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY



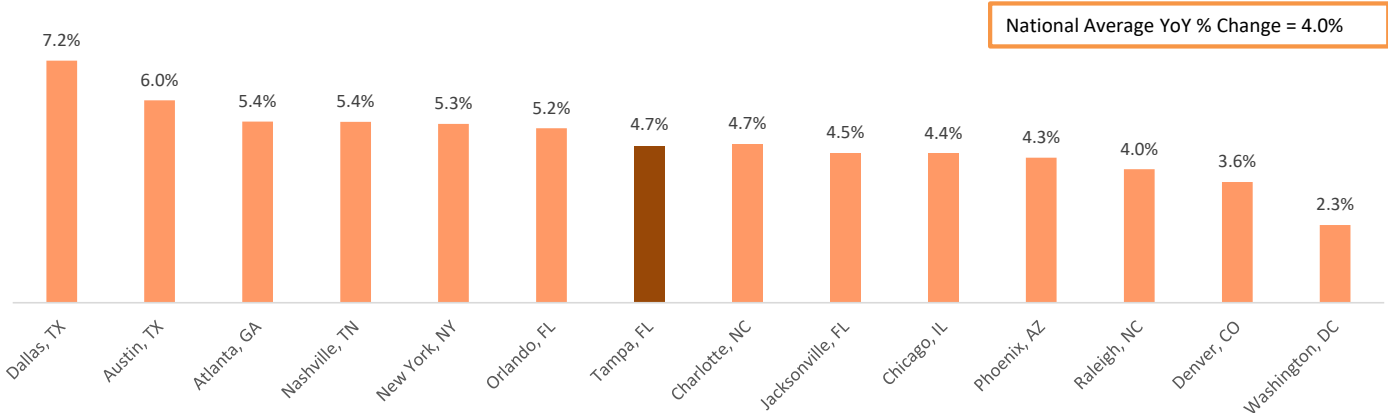
Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)
