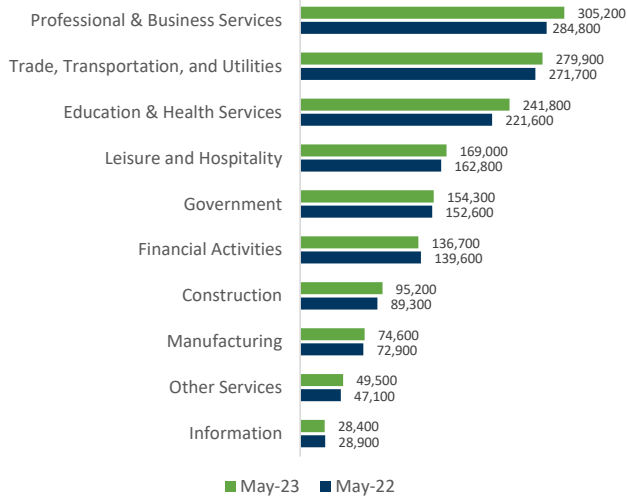
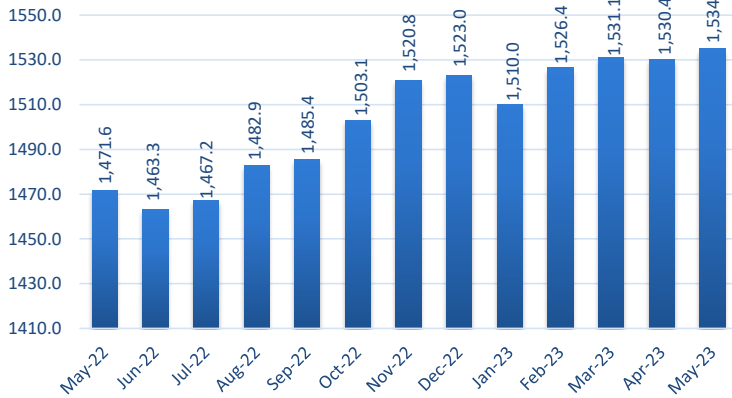


Tampa's total nonfarm payroll employment had the largest increase in the state of Florida for the third month in a row adding over 63,300 jobs for a gain of 4.3% since May 2022. Other Florida metros with the largest gains were Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+51,100 jobs, +4.1%) and Orlando (+50,300 jobs, +3.6%). Industries gaining the most jobs in Tampa over last year include professional and business services (+20,400), education and health services (+20,200) and trade, transportation and utilities (+8,200). Professional and business services, trade, transportation, and utilities, and education and health services currently account for 54% of the industry share. In the past five years, employment in the Tampa MSA grew 9.6% - more than the state of Florida and the nation.

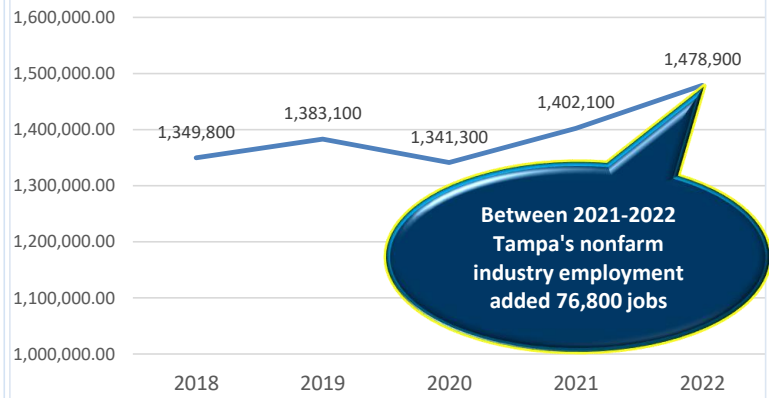
TAMPA MSA INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT YOY



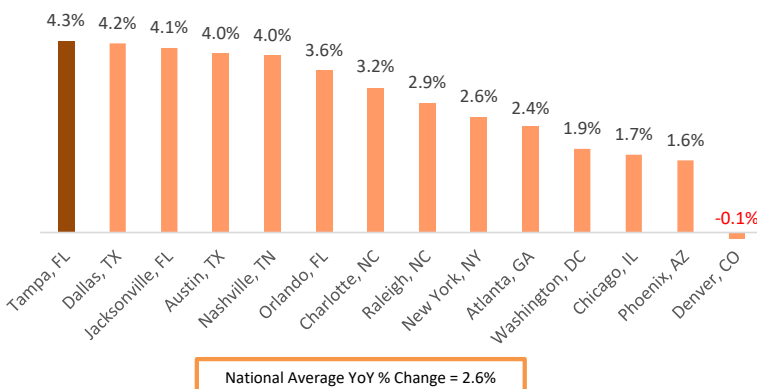
Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (000)
